Bate Stamp Feature for the Aficio 2090 and 2105 Digital Imaging Systems



Ricoh is pleased to announce the release of the new **Bate Stamp Feature** for the *Aficio 2090 and 2105 Digital Imaging Systems*. This new feature is designed to streamline the workflow process of applying a “Bate Stamp” to documents scanned on the *Aficio 2090 and 2105 Digital Imaging Systems*.

What is Bate Stamping?

Bate Stamping is a major requirement of the legal marketplace, which has the need to apply a sequential stamp to hard copy originals that are scanned into the *Aficio 2090 and 2105 Systems*.

The stamp is normally is comprised of both **Alpha** and **Numeric** digits.

Bate Stamping is used to help the legal customer identify specific case documents for both internal file control, as well as for use with providing those documents for disclosure.

BATE STAMP HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Modifies the Stamp Text and the Page Numbering Feature and turns them into a “Bate Stamp” that is placed on the output of hard copy scanned documents.**
- **Up to 40 Alpha characters can now be utilized**
(Example: Kitamura Dizzine Henry and Mulroony)
- **9 Sequential Numeric Characters are preceded by zeros**
(Example: 00000001)
- **Bate Stamp consists of Alpha and Sequential Numeric Characters normally utilized for legal applications**
(Example: Kitamura Dizzine Henry and Mulroony 00000001)
- **Batch Mode can be used to keep the Sequential Numbering consistent for more than 100 documents at a time.**

How The Bate Stamp Feature Works:

- This feature consists of Alpha Characters followed by 9 digit Numeric Characters (Example: Kitamura Dizzine Henry and Mulroony 000000001) by making "**Page Numbering**" feature inactivated.
- Alpha Characters can be added with current "**Stamp Text**" feature. (Spaces can be added between Alpha Characters)
- The numerical characters will count up automatically and will not print after **999999999**.
- The last numerical characters can be saved even if the main power is turned [OFF].
- The position for 9 digit numerical part can be adjusted under [**Stamp Position: P1, P2...**] with User Tools. The rest of the options will be inactivated.
- Batch mode can be used with this feature.
- This feature does not print correctly in **Connect Copy, Job Preset** and **Interrupt** copy modes.
