

COLLEGE OBSOLESCENCE MINUTE

50 STUDENTS IN FIELDS SUCH AS IT OR ENGINEERING

learn skills that are either outdated or soon to be replaced

R ENGINEERING CERTIFICATIONS

related to specific technologies or professions become obsolete, often because newer certifications or licenses have replaced them.

3 INDUSTRY

2 COLLEGES DEGREE BECOMES OUTDATED

update or replace entire curriculums due to relevancy

1 TRADITIONAL

or less relevant in the job market

4 GRADUATES

with Irrelevant Degrees face difficulty finding jobs directly related to their college major because the field has been disrupted by technology.

2 RELATED CAREER PATHS FACE OBSOLESCENCE

or significant disruption due to automation or changing industry needs, such as certain financial analysts, & paralegals

3 TRADITIONAL JOBS REQUIRING DEGREES ARE PHASED OUT

or replaced by automated systems every minute.

2 SKILLED TRADES WORKERS

complete professional certifications

5 CONSTRUCTION-RELATED JOBS

are added globally

THE SHORTAGE OF SKILLED TRADES WORKERS

grows by 1 position each minute as demand exceeds the supply of qualified workers

4 STUDENTS

enroll in trade schools

1 NEW APPRENTICE

starts in a skilled trade program

WAGES FOR SKILLED TRADES

grow by \$1,200 globally each minute

2 NEWLY TRAINED TRADESPEOPLE

join the workforce every minute globally

VETERANS MINUTE

18 MILLION

military Veterans in the United States.

17 VETERANS DIE PER DAY BY SUICIDE

meaning a veteran dies by suicide every 85 minutes.

0.5 VETERANS

are hired into civilian jobs every minute in the U.S.

transitions to veteran status after leaving active duty service.

2 VETERANS

enter the civilian workforce each minute in the U.S

3 VETERANS

begin using the GI Bill for education-related benefits each minute.
